

After SC relief to five, another northeast Delhi riots accused moves for bail

New Delhi: Days after the Supreme Court granted bail to five accused in the 2020 Delhi riots conspiracy case, another accused has filed a bail application in a court, contending that he is facing similar charges and seeking parity. The bail application was filed by Athar Khan, a former call centre employee accused of being one of the main organisers of the protest in northeast

Delhi and allegedly delivering inflammatory speeches there. The application moved before Additional Sessions Judge Sameer Bajpai contends that the Supreme Court granted bail to another accused facing similar charges and that he stands on the same footing. The court listed Khan's bail application for hearing on Jan 19. PTI

With 81 new arogya mandirs, Delhi now has 319 such centres

New Delhi: Delhi on Wednesday expanded its primary healthcare network with the inauguration of 81 new Ayushman Arogya Mandirs, taking the total number of centres in the capital to 319.

Chief minister Rekha Gupta inaugurated the new facilities from Hari Nagar on Makar Sankranti, as part of the govt's expansion plan to set up 15 arogya mandirs in every Assembly constituency and scale the network up to 1,100 centres citywide.

Describing the centres as "a guarantee of dignified treatment close to home", Gupta said the initiative was aimed at strengthening neighbourhood-level healthcare and easing pressure on tertiary hospitals. During an inspection of one of the facilities, she reviewed OPD rooms, laboratories, vaccination units, medicine counters

and maternal and child health services, and interacted with the medical staff. She also examined the digital health record system and directed officials to ensure transparency and accuracy.

Gupta said the expansion marked a departure from years of stalled health infrastructure projects. "Several hospital projects remained incomplete earlier. We are now finishing them within a defined framework and with transparency," she said.

In another development, health minister Pankaj Kumar Singh reiterated the govt's focus on preventive and community healthcare while inaugurating new initiatives at the Institute of Liver and Biliary Sciences. These included a toll-free 'Liver Gyan' helpline (1800113354), an 18-month liver disease screening and awareness programme titled 'The Delhi Model: Healthy Liver, Healthy Delhi'.

Dwarka To Get Mini Secretariat, 12 More Planned

Move To Strengthen Governance

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New Delhi: Delhi govt has cleared the construction of the South West district mini secretariat in Sector 10 of Dwarka at an estimated Rs 212.9 crore. The secretariat is part of a push to strengthen district-level governance and public service delivery.

The proposal was approved by the expenditure finance committee (EFC). The chief minister directed that such mini secretariats should be made in all 13 revenue districts to focus on public interface and citizen-centric service delivery. The revenue department was asked to assess land availability, financial implications and requirements and submit a detailed proposal for completing all 13 buildings in two years.

To decentralise administration, the mini secretariats will house most local govt departments, such as MCD zonal offices, under one roof. Chief minister Rekha Gupta said this would end the inconvenience of having to run to multiple offices. It is expected to improve inter-department coordination and make monitoring and review by district officials more efficient.

The revenue department has identified the making of mini secretariats as one of 11 critical action areas in its strategy map for 2025-26. "The project is part of a broader administrative reform... The need for district mini secretariats has grown as the role of district authorities has expanded beyond traditional functions such as land administration," an official said.

The proposal was placed before the EFC after a

presentation by the divisional commissioner recently. The proposed building will have a total covered area of 35,535 sq metres, including 21,737 sq metres of building space and 13,798 sq metres of basement parking.

The project is expected to be completed in phases over three financial years — Rs 1 crore in 2025-26, Rs 110.7 crore in 2026-27, and Rs 101.9 crore in 2027-28. While the initial proposal provided for a completion timeline of 26 months, officials were directed that the executing agency has to complete the project in 18 months.

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"The EFC stressed the need to adhere to timelines and warned against cost overruns. It directed that stringent penalty and performance clauses should be built into tender documents and that quality control mechanisms, including third-party inspections, be put in place. A project monitoring committee will be formed to track progress and submit periodic reports to the administrative secretary," an official said.

Officials said the mini secretariats will be developed as zero-waste facilities, equipped with solar power systems, sewage treatment plants and water or mist sprinklers. "Once completed, the Dwarka mini secretariat is expected to serve as the model," said a govt official.

DG NCB flags rising menace of synthetic drugs

New Delhi: The director general of Narcotics Control Bureau flagged the rising menace of synthetic drugs and pointed the shift of drug syndicates towards misuse of precursor chemicals. DG Anurag Garg at an event stressed on adopting voluntary codes of conduct and practise collective vigilance. TNN

12-year-old boy among 5 minors held for robbing tutor near AIIMS

New Delhi: Five minors, including a 12-year-old boy, have been apprehended for allegedly assaulting and robbing a 54-year-old tutor near the Safdarjung-AIIMS flyover in southwest Delhi, police said on Wednesday.

The incident took place early Saturday when the tutor, returning from a friend's dinner in Arjun Nagar around 2.30am, was walking home. According to the FIR, near the loop road from Safdarjung to Ring Road around 3am, a group of boys stopped him asking for a cigarette. When he said he didn't have one, they allegedly threatened him and demanded money.

Police said the tutor was robbed of his mobile phone and Rs 35,200 in cash, following which the accused fled towards the Safdarjung side. A PCR call regarding the incident was received around 3.52am, and a case was registered at the Sarojini Nagar police station.

Deputy commissioner of police (southwest) Amit Goel said based on local intelligence and technical surveillance, five minors were apprehended.

During questioning, one of the teenagers allegedly confessed to being the main offender, saying he stopped and robbed the victim, with the stolen money shared among the group. Police said the stolen cash has been recovered. TNN

Man absconding for 18 yrs caught

New Delhi: Delhi Police has arrested a 48-year-old man from Manali, Himachal Pradesh, nearly 18 years after he jumped bail in multiple cheating and forgery cases linked to an organised bank fraud syndicate.

The accused, Amit Nishchal, who was working as a hotel manager, had been living under a fake identity to evade arrest. A former resident of Gurgaon, he was declared a proclaimed offender in a 2001 Delhi case.

Deputy commissioner of police (Crime) Harsh Indora said using technical surveillance, they traced Nishchal's movements to Manali, where a team arrested him. Investigations have revealed that Nishchal was allegedly involved in a similar case of theft and forgery registered by Mumbai CID in 2001. TNN
